There are no prerequisite courses required before you can begin the CFP® Certification Education or ChFC® Programs.

To use the ChFC® designation, you are required to have three years of full-time, relevant business experience and a high school diploma or the equivalent.


To receive and maintain the ChFC® designation, you must:

- Successfully complete the eight required courses
- Agree to comply with The American College Code of Ethics and Procedures
- Participate in the annual Professional Recertification Program (PRP)

To receive and maintain the CFP mark, you must:

- Successfully complete the seven required courses in our CFP Certification
 Education Program and pass the CFP exam
- Receive a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- Complete either 6,000 hours of professional experience as a financial advisor OR 4,000 hours of apprenticeship experience
- Complete Continuing Education (CE) credit requirements as directed by the CFP Board, as well as abide by their Code of Ethics
