
To receive the CLF® designation, you must:

- Participate in the annual Professional Recertification Program (PRP)

Your learning journey doesn't have to begin or end with earning your CLF® designation. Because designees enroll in the program as preparation for an expanded leadership role, many financial services professionals earn their CLF® after acquiring designations such as the CLU®, ChFC®, and CFP® certification. Senior leaders can also view CLF® as a designation that begins a learning path into The College's Master of Science in Management (MSM) Program.
